- Familiarity with the five divisions and five core values of WSM
- Ability to support and respect the Christian faith and values of WSM
- Ability to understand and follow directions
- Ability to work effectively with others and without direct supervision
- Strict respect of confidentiality
- Able to manage details with accuracy and consistency
- Comfortable using an adding machine and working with numbers
- Should be detail-oriented
- Ability to multi-task
