

COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS – REQUIRED FOR HIGH SCHOOL OR COLLEGE CLASS:

Volunteer opportunities are available in our Dining Hall for students needing to fulfill community service hours for high school.

Steps:

1. Student must create an account online at: <https://wsm.volunteerhub.com> to begin the application process.
 - a. Create Username & Password – Click NEXT
 - b. Leave Join Code field blank – Click NEXT
 - c. Check the box
 - i. I NEED SERVICE HOURS FOR A HIGH SCHOOL CLASS – or –
 - ii. I NEED SERVICE HOURS FOR A COLLEGE CLASS
 - d. Follow the prompts to complete the application
2. Once the student has successfully created the account, he/she should click NEXT to sign up for a New Volunteer Orientation.
3. Once the orientation has been completed, student will have account permissions to view and sign up for volunteer opportunities.

Students under the age of 18:

Please note that...

- The minimum age to serve at Water Street Mission (WSM) is 13 years old.
- Youth ages 13-15:
 - A parent or legal guardian must serve with the minor and accompany the minor at all times.
 - A parent or legal guardian must also create a volunteer account online and register to serve with the minor.
 - A parent or legal guardian must complete and submit a Minor Liability Waiver before the student's first serve date.
- Youth ages 16-17:
 - An adult who is responsible for the minor (i.e., parent, legal guardian, teacher, coach or youth leader) must serve with the minor and accompany the minor at all times.
 - The adult serving with the minor must also create a volunteer account online and register to serve with the minor.
 - A parent or legal guardian must complete and submit a Minor Liability Waiver before the student's first serve date.
