Volunteer Age Policy

Thank you for understanding that, for liability and safety purposes...

- The minimum age to serve at Water Street Mission (WSM) is 13 years old.
- Youth ages 13-15: a parent or legal guardian must serve with the minor and accompany the minor at all times. Parent or legal guardian must complete Minor Waiver and submit it before the Minor's first date of service.
- Youth ages 16-17: an adult who is responsible for the minor (i.e., parent, legal guardian, teacher, coach or youth leader) must serve with the minor and accompany the minor at all times. Parent or legal guardian must complete Minor Waiver and submit it before the Minor's first date of service.

3. You will be asked to complete a Volunteer Orientation – either online or on campus – for your account to be approved.
