

Work Directly with Middle School & High School Students (Teen Haven)

Teen Haven helps launch teens from our Lancaster City community into a life of leadership and purpose. By providing a safe and nurturing environment – and mentoring them to become leaders in their city, churches and schools – Teen Haven is building a stronger foundation for a thriving community.

Commitment:

These opportunities are for individuals who are willing to commit to serving a minimum of once per week for a minimum of three months.

Volunteer Age Policy:

Teen Haven Volunteers must be at least 18 years old and fulfill the requirements listed on the individual volunteer job descriptions.

Next Steps:

1. If you are interested in applying for a position in Teen Haven, please contact the Volunteer Office to inquire about available openings. Should there be an opening you would like to apply for, the Volunteer Office will ask you to fill out a Teen Haven Volunteer Application.*
2. Individuals moving forward in the process will be invited to “job shadow” and attend a volunteer orientation.
3. If both you and Teen Haven staff determine this position might be a good fit, Teen Haven staff will work with you to determine your volunteer schedule.

*Because Teen Haven Volunteers are working directly with children, background clearances are required.
