

Work Directly with PreK & Kindergarten Students (Wonder Club)

Wonder Club provides daily Pre-K and Kindergarten classes for children from primarily low-income families who could otherwise not afford a private Christian education.

Volunteers could assist with lunch to set out trays, hand out lunch items and assist children with opening condiment packages, milk, etc. Volunteers may also apply to help in the classroom or at recess as needs arise.

Commitment:

These opportunities are for individuals who are willing to commit to serving a minimum of once per week for a minimum of three months.

Volunteer Age Policy:

Wonder Club Volunteers must be at least 18 years old and fulfill the requirements listed on the individual volunteer job descriptions.

Next Steps:

1. If you are interested in applying for a position in Wonder Club, please contact the Volunteer Office to inquire about available openings. Should there be an opening you would like to apply for, the Volunteer Office will ask you to fill out a Wonder Club Volunteer Application.*
2. Individuals moving forward in the process will be invited to “job shadow” and attend a volunteer orientation.
3. If both you and Wonder Club staff determine this position might be a good fit, Wonder Club staff will work with you to determine your volunteer schedule.

*Because Wonder Club Volunteers are working directly with children, background clearances are required.
