Summary: Responsible for assisting teachers in ministering to children. This is a school year position (9 months)

FLSA: Hourly, PT

The Wonder Club's Teacher Assistant must be:

- 1. Willing to sign the Water Street Mission Statement of Faith
- 2. A current member or regular attendee of a local church
- 3. Able to fully support Water Street Mission's core values and philosophy of ministry.

Essential Functions:

□ To share the gospel of Jesus Christ with children and parents as opportunities arise.
 □ To maintain programs for assigned children in the following domain areas; spiritual, physical, social, academic, creative, emotional needs.
 □ To assist classroom teachers with daily routines (setting/cleaning up for activities, preparing snack time & children ready to go outside, etc).
 □ To interact with children during learning center and free play times.
 □ To plan and/or teach Bible, and implement other lesson plans as delegated by Lead Teacher.
 □ To assist teachers in transitioning children from one activity to the next.
 □ To communicate matters of concern: students or parents to the appropriate teacher. Matters of concern about staff report to the Lead Teacher.
 □ To assure that "school" tools/materials are properly maintained, stored, and put-away.

Education and Experience:

□ Other duties as assigned.

Physical Demands:
