Summary: The Mission Support Assistant is a flexible position designed to provide assistance in the different functions within Water Street Mission. This hands-on role supports food services, warehouse, custodial, and other essential functions within the organization.

FLSA: Non-Exempt, Full-Time

The Mission Support Assistant must be:

- 1. Willing to sign the Water Street Mission Statement of Faith
- 2. A current and active member and/or regular attendee of a local church.
- 3. Able to fully support the Water Street Mission's core values and ministry philosophy.

Essential Functions:

- Basic food prep with the willingness to learn additional cooking skills
- Supporting the Custodian Facilities Team Member position by cleaning assigned areas
- Assisting the Warehouse Facilitator with organizing inventory and sorting donations
- Administrative and customer support responsibilities
- Support our Access Center team answering phone calls and providing customer service to quests
- Assist our Outreach Program Manager with the distribution of food to the community
- Show flexibility to perform other responsibilities as assigned to support different departments within Water Street Mission.

Education/Experience:

The Mission Support Assistant is an entry-level position with the most important values being a heart for ministry and a desire to learn and grow. Agreement with the philosophy of Water Street Mission is essential. Competency in Microsoft Office products is preferred.

Physical Demands:

Occasionally = 1%-33%; Frequently = 34%-66%; Continuously = 67%-100%

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this position.

- Stand, walk, or sit *continuously*
- Reach with hands and arms *frequently*
- Stoop, kneel, or crouch occasionally
- Lift and/or move up to 50 pounds *occasionally*
