## WSM Job Description Temporary Prep Cook and Dockworker

## Summary:

Assist in in food services by preparing food, receiving donations, assisting with product storage and inventory control, and cleaning in an institutional setting. This temporary position is not benefits eligible.

FLSA: Temporary 90 Day Position, full-time, non-exempt

The Temporary Prep Cook and Dockworker must be able to support the core values and philosophy of ministry held by Water Street Ministries.

## Essential Functions:

- Assist in the preparation and serving of food items in accordance with menu specifications and established food safety practices as directed by supervisor
- Operates and cleans various kitchen equipment.
- Assist donors at food dock in a pleasant and courteous manner
- Receive product at the dock, use pallet jack or forklift to move product for proper storage
- Keep the dock area clean and organized, including fridges, freezer, restroom and shelves
- Ensure that proper sanitation and food safety procedures are followed
- Works in harmony with all staff, guests and volunteers
- Perform other duties as assigned.

*Education/Skills:* High School Diploma or G.E.D required, general math competency, computer proficiency on databases and email communications, experience in a retail or food service industry preferred. Able to lift 50lbs, experience using a forklift is preferred. Willing to provide leadership to volunteers, excels in a fast-paced work environment, enjoys food service and working in a team environment. This position will work some weekends and holidays.

## Physical Demands:

Occasionally = 1%-33%; Frequently = 34%-66%; Continuously = 67%-100%

- Stand, walk, or sit *continuously*
