- Recruit, train and supervise volunteers, as requested by the Teen Haven director
- Assist in representing Teen Haven among donors and community partners
- Create a safe, fun and loving environment
- Work in full coordination with Teen Haven/WSM staff team at all times to identify, report and respond appropriately to any potential threats to the safety and wellbeing of youth
