Children's Ministry Coach

Summary: To participate in the spiritual and emotional growth of each family (woman and children) through Biblical ministry & trauma informed care; involving each woman and child in experiences to promote the learning of healthy life-skills while actively participating in a healing environment and the Core Values of Water Street Mission.

The Children's Ministry Coach must be:

- Willing to sign the Water Street Mission Statement of Faith
- □ A current member or regular attendee of a local church
- □ Able to fully support the Water Street Mission core values and ministry philosophy

Essential Duties:

- □ Facilitate children's Ministry responsible for opening & closing the Children's Ministry room, supervising volunteers, monitoring safety of the children.
- Apply a trauma informed approach ensuring children's safety while mom's are in classes, Life Coach Sessions or Case Management meetings
- Maintain appropriate records & documentation in our database & through e-mail
- Ensure room is organized and clean
- Communicate observations and concerns to the Children's Ministry Coordinator or Supervisor on duty
- Serve as a parenting coach to female guests as assigned.
- Relate & teach life skills to children ages birth to 18
- Available evenings as assigned and as the need may arise in crisis situations.
- Cooperate and coordinate with Life Coaches & Case Managers in care for Guests
- Continue to be an active part of the spiritual development of the Children's Ministry
- Participate in special programs and events and in educational/training opportunities as requested (back-toschool supply programs, Christmas activities, etc)
- Communicate and cooperate with other WSM workers as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

How duties will be performed:

- Maintain a compassionate witness, exercising firmness with love and demonstrating joy
- Maintain appropriate boundaries with the women & children guests as directed by the Children's Ministry Coordinator and Director of Residential Ministries
- Communicate a perspective that aligns with a 'Bible-above' approach to culture
- Understand & articulate a perspective that balances the Biblical concepts of grace and truth

Education and Experience: Experience teaching, developing lesson plans and working with at-risk

children is required. Degree in teaching, experience in childhood development from ages of birth - 18, & 3-5 years of experience in a learning environment are required. Compassionate, ministry-minded person with an ability to connect with at risk families and build healthy relationships. Competency in Microsoft Office Products required. Knowledge in Outlook & ability to work with a database. Bilingual preferred.

Physical Demands:

Occasionally = 1%-33%; Frequently = 34%-66%; Continuously = 67%-100%

- Stand, walk, or sit *continuously*
- Use hands to finger, handle, or feel *continuously*
